This is just a quick message to clear up some misinformation that has been circulating among UGFA members.

Your chair may ask to see your course outlines before the start of the semester to ensure compliance with the AODA (Accessibility for Ontarions with Disabilities Act). Our Collective Agreement is silent on all matters pertaining to course outlines, so deadlines for the submission of course outlines are set solely by the Administration. The date on which students have access to CourseLink, and course outlines and other course materials you may post there, is similarly set solely by the Administration.

A “netiquette” guide for students has been circulated by OpenEd and suggested for distribution to students by instructors. Some faculty have been told that the UGFA endorsed this document. On the contrary, when the UGFA received a first draft, we strenuously objected to a number of items included therein. The document was revised before it was released for wider circulation, but it was not endorsed by the UGFA.
