On April 28, you should have received a note from upp@uoguelph.ca signed by Barbara Zvan (UPP CEO) and Gale Rubenstein (Chair, UPP Board of Trustees). This note mentioned some ways that you, as a soon-to-be University Pension Plan (UPP) member, could receive and share information with the UPP administration as we approach the July 1, 2021, conversion of our current Professional Pension Plan to the UPP.

A key item in the note was the announcement of two sessions in May:

- On May 13, 10:00am-11:30am, there will be an Investment Town Hall for the University of Guelph (the note called this an "Investment Listening Session").
- On May 27, 5:30pm-6:30pm, there will be an "All-Member Information Session"

The body of the email did not mention the dates, but did provide a bit more detail, along with other ways to connect.

The April 28 email is the first page of the attached PDF, and all hyperlinks function. To register for either (or both) of the above sessions, click on the link and work your way through the subsequent eventbrite registration screens. The process might be a little confusing, since you need the password from the email and you must click a "Register" button on three different screens. The attached PDF includes screen captures that walk through the process.

Please note that, as the ticket you receive reports (see last page of the attached PDF), "The instructions to enter will be sent by the organizer prior to the event start time." You will receive the link to the event through the registered email address some time before the event.
