

Negotiator #6 October 3, 2024

On Friday, September 27, the UGFA Bargaining Team and the Administration met with a conciliator from the Ministry of Labour. Because the parties did not reach an agreement, the conciliator was sent away, then asked to issue a "no board" report. Once this report is issued, and after 17 days have passed, a strike or lockout may be called. After the conciliator was sent away, the UGFA Bargaining Team and the Administration continued to meet.

Although agreement has been reached on a number smaller matters, the key issues that remain on the table are workload, modes of course delivery, and compensation. The parties have agreed to use Bill Kaplan as a mediator/arbitrator, and we have booked him for the weekend of October 19 and 20, from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. on both days. In the meantime, discussions between the two bargaining teams continue.

The UGFA Strike Committee has been actively planning for a possible strike. Please know that preparing for a strike does not mean that a strike is inevitable.
